## 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 2, delete lines 19 through 22 in their entirety
- 3 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 4 On page 3, between lines 16 and 17, insert the following:
- "F. (1) A health insurance issuer providing coverage pursuant to this
   Section may limit the benefit payable for nonsurgical services described
   in this Section to not less than one thousand five hundred dollars per
   policy year. For purposes of this Paragraph, "nonsurgical services"
   shall include any of the following:
- 10 (a) Physician office visits related to a morbid obesity diagnosis and treatment and subsequent follow-up visits.
- 12 **(b)** Health and behavior assessments.
- 13 (c) Nutrition education.
- 14 (d) Patient self-management education and training.
- 15 (2) The benefit limit of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection shall not apply to treatment for the comorbidity factors of hypertension or diabetes.
- 17 (3) A health insurance issuer providing coverage pursuant to this Section
  18 may limit the benefit payable for drugs prescribed for weight loss used
  19 in the treatment of morbid obesity prior to surgery to not less than one

thousand eight hundred dollars per policy year.

- 21 (4) The annual benefit limits described in this Subsection shall be in addition to any cost sharing requirements payable by the insured in accordance with the applicable policy of insurance.
