2 To amend and reenact R.S. 33:1991(A)(1), relative to employees of fire departments; to

provide relative to the applicability of provisions pertaining to wages and hours; and

to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 33:1991(A)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§1991. Definitions

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A.(1) The word "fireman", as used in this Subpart includes all persons employed or engaged full-time by municipalities or municipal fire departments, parishes or parish fire departments, or fire protection districts for firefighting, or fire prevention, fire record clerk, fire investigation, fire protection, or emergency duties and services, or for training of such persons. as well as The word "fireman" also includes employees of nonprofit corporations under contract with a fire protection district or other political subdivision to provide such services, including operators of the fire-alarm system when such operators are members of the regularly constituted fire department. The word "fireman" does not include carpenters, storekeepers, machinists, clerks, except fire record clerks, building hazard and similar inspectors, physicians, or other non-firefighting employees detailed for such special duties, nor does the word "fireman", except as otherwise provided in this

**Abstract:** Provides relative to the definition of "fireman" with respect to provisions pertaining to minimum wages and maximum hours.

<u>Present law</u> provides with respect to wages, hours, sick leave, and vacation for firemen and other employees of fire departments.

<u>Present law</u> defines "fireman" to include all persons employed or engaged full-time by municipalities or municipal fire departments, parishes or parish fire departments, or fire protection districts for firefighting, or fire prevention duties and services.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds persons employed for fire record clerk, fire investigation, fire protection, and emergency duties and services to definition. Also adds persons employed to provide training for persons covered by <u>present law</u> and <u>proposed law</u>.
