AN ACT
To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1666.1(A)(3)(c), relative to internal statutory references in provisions dealing with supplemental pay for firefighters and police officers; to amend such a statutory reference; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 40:1666.1(A)(3)(c) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
§1666.1. Extra compensation

(3)
(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no municipality, parish, fire protection district, or other political subdivision maintaining a fire department, or the Chitimacha Tribe of Louisiana or the Coushatta Indian Tribe of Louisiana, or any such nonprofit corporation contracting to provide fire protection services, shall be subject to penalty for reducing the salary of any employee whose salary has been enhanced pursuant to this Paragraph for one year by an amount not exceeding the amount of such enhancement. Any such reduction shall not be void as provided in R.S. 40:1667.4 40:1666.4.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
