Amendments proposed by House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 38 by Senator Johns

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 4, line 7, after "service." insert "If two or more employees share identical
- 3 promotional seniority in a class, those employees shall be demoted in order of their
- 4 departmental seniority with the demotion of the employee with the least departmental
- 5 seniority being demoted first amongst those with identical promotional seniority."

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

- 7 On page 5, at the end of line 24, after "class." insert "If two or more employees share
- 8 identical promotional seniority in a class, those employees shall be listed in order of
- 9 their departmental seniority, from highest to lowest, amongst those with identical
- 10 promotional seniority."

11 AMENDMENT NO. 3

- On page 6, at the end of line 6, after "established." insert "If two or more employees share
- 13 identical promotional seniority in a class, those employees shall be listed in order of
- 14 their departmental seniority, from highest to lowest, amongst those with identical
- 15 promotional seniority."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 8, between lines 9 and 10, insert:

- 18 "(d) If two or more employees share identical promotional 19 seniority in a class, those employees shall be reinstated, or selected and
- 20 appointed for promotion, in order of their departmental seniority with
- the reinstatement or promotion being offered to the employee with the greatest departmental seniority amongst those with identical
- 23 **promotional seniority.**"

24 AMENDMENT NO. 5

- On page 8, at the end of line 27, after "lowest." insert "If two or more employees share
- 26 identical promotional seniority in a class, priority to positions amongst those employees
- 27 shall be in order of their total departmental seniority in the order of highest to lowest
- 28 <u>amongst those with identical promotional seniority."</u>
