5 WHEREAS, Hugh O'Brian, the Hollywood star who portrayed Wyatt Earp in the
6 television series "The Life and Legend of Wyatt Earp", founded the Hugh O'Brian Youth
7 Leadership Foundation in 1958; and

8 WHEREAS, the Hugh O'Brian Youth Leadership Foundation, also known as HOBY,
9 organizes and promotes annual leadership seminars for thousands of high school sophomores
10 throughout the United States and abroad; and

11 WHEREAS, the objectives of the Hugh O'Brian Youth Leadership program are to
12 seek out, recognize, develop, and reward leadership potential in high school students, to
13 encourage and assist young people in their quests for self-identification and self
14 development, to host workshops for young people with recognized leaders in business,
15 industry, government, science, and education, and to stimulate opportunities for young
16 people to demonstrate their leadership abilities for the benefit of their communities and their
17 country; and
