- 2. Make a technical change.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

SB 212 Reengrossed

<u>Present law</u> provides that bowhunters may carry on their person, while hunting with a bow, a pistol no larger than a .22 caliber with snake shot or rat shot ammunition for the purposes of killing snakes and rats.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes bowhunters to carry any caliber firearm on their person while hunting with a bow.

<u>Proposed law</u> shall not limit the ability of the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to regulate hunting activities in a wildlife management area.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
