<u>Prior law</u> provided for the discipline of students for disorderly conduct in school, on school playgrounds, while going to and from school, or during intermission or recess.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> for students in grades six through twelve, but prohibits the suspension or expulsion of a student in grades prekindergarten through five from school or suspended from riding on a school bus for a uniform violation that is not tied to willful disregard of school policies.

<u>New law</u> applies to charter schools. Further provides that no charter school shall suggest to a parent that it is authorized to suspend or expel a student for a uniform violation that is not tied to willful disregard of school policies.

Effective upon signature of the governor (June 29, 2015).
