1	The amount of the fee may be changed by duly adopted resolution of the
2	commission, not to exceed the maximum amount authorized as provided in this
3	Subsection. No other election shall be required except as provided by this Paragraph.

5	(c) If approved, the fee shall expire on December 31, 2014 ten years after
6	its levy, but the fee may be renewed if approved by a majority of the registered
7	voters of the district voting on the proposition at an election as provided in
8	Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph. Any election to authorize the renewal of the fee
9	shall be held for that purpose in accordance with the Louisiana Election Code. If the
10	fee is renewed, the term of the imposition of the fee shall be as provided in the
11	proposition authorizing such renewal, not to exceed eight ten years.

13	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
14	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
15	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
16	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
17	effective on the day following such approval.
