REC NO IMPACT See Note Legislative Sessions: (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for matters which may be considered in a regular session

convening in an odd-numbered year.

The proposed constitutional amendment changes "dedicated revenue" to "legislate with regard to the dedication of revenue"; and changes "levy or authorize a new tax, increase an existing tax, and legislate with regard to tax exemptions, exclusions, deductions, reductions, repeals, or credits" to "legislate with regard to taxes; legislate with regard to rebates" in the subject matters which may be considered in a regular session convening in an odd-numbered year. The proposed constitutional amendment shall be submitted to the electors at the statewide election to be held on October 24, 2015.
