6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 3:3382(3), 3386(A), and 3388(A) are hereby amended and reenacted
8	to read as follows:
9	§3382. Definitions
10	As used in this Part, the following terms shall have the following meanings
11	ascribed to them:

13	(3) "School" means any public or private day or residential school that
14	provides <u>pre-kindergarten</u> , elementary, or secondary education.

16	§3386. Application of pesticides by certified commercial applicator
17	A. No person shall apply or supervise the application of any herbicide,
18	rodenticide, insecticide, or restricted use pesticide, on a non-fee basis for grass and
19	weed control, and rodent and general pest control in, on, or around structures or
20	grounds of schools that provide education to kindergarten pre-kindergarten through
21	twelfth grade classes, unless that person is a certified commercial applicator or is
22	under the supervision of a certified commercial applicator as provided in R.S. 3:3242
23	and the rules and regulations adopted thereunder. Such certified commercial

applicator shall be trained in integrated pest management that includes but is not limited to pest prevention, least toxic methods of pest control, and applying pesticides judiciously. Training material shall include but not be limited to the guidelines in the EPA publication "Pest Control in the School Environment: Adopting Integrated Pest Management".

§3388. Annual integrated pest management plan

A.(1) The governing authority of each school, including but not limited to superintendents, headmasters, school boards, boards of directors, chief executive officers, or principals, shall prepare and submit, for each school under its authority, an annual integrated pest management plan that applies integrated pest management strategies of pest prevention methods and strongly recommends the least toxic methods of control for grass and weed control, and rodent and general pest control in, on, or around school structures and grounds.

(2) Each city, parish, or other local public school board shall submit a single, comprehensive integrated pest management plan for all schools under its jurisdiction.
