<u>Existing constitution</u> authorizes the imposition of ad valorem property taxes by local governments.

<u>Prior constitution</u> provided an exemption from ad valorem property tax for public lands and other public property used for public purposes.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> changes <u>prior constitution</u> by specifying that the exemption does not apply to land or property owned by another state or by a political subdivision of another state.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Oct. 24, 2015.
