**ACT 70 (HB 345)**

Existing law requires the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to require the Accountability Commission, which was established by the board, to convene an advisory subcommittee of the commission to report on and make recommendations regarding the effectiveness of the professional employee evaluation program, including but not limited to any recommendations for changes to policy or existing law relative to the value-added model, growth measures, elements of evaluation, and standards for effectiveness. Provides for an initial report and recommendations from the subcommittee to the board and the House and Senate committees on education in 2015 and requires a subsequent report and further recommendations prior to the 2016 R.S.

<u>New law</u> additionally authorizes the advisory subcommittee to consider and advise the board regarding whether adjustments to regulations proposed by the state Dept. of Education and referred to the subcommittee by the board should be adopted, rejected, or modified.

Effective August 1, 2015.
