<u>New law</u> requires the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to issue special prestige license plates to be known as the "Challenge ALS" license plates.

<u>New law</u> provides that the ALS Association Louisiana-Mississippi Chapter will select the color and design of the license plate. Specifies that the design shall include the words "Challenge ALS".

<u>New law</u> specifies that the license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

<u>New law</u> requires the department to collect an annual royalty fee of \$30, as well as a handling fee of \$3.50 for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of administrative costs.

<u>New law</u> provides that monies collected by the department be forwarded to the ALS Association Louisiana-Mississippi Chapter or its successor organization. Specifies that the monies will be used for amyotrophic lateral sclerosis research.

Effective Aug. 1, 2015.
