<u>Existing law</u> provides for a Public Service Commission consisting of 5 members elected from single-member districts established by law. Requires members to be elected at congressional elections for overlapping terms of 6 years. Additionally requires members to be qualified electors and to take office and begin their terms on the first day of January following election.

<u>New law</u> adds that to be eligible for election to the commission, a candidate must at the time of qualification satisfy the following requirements:

- (1) Attained the age of 18 years.
- (2) Resided in the state for the preceding 2 years.
- (3) Been actually domiciled for the preceding year in the district from which he seeks election.

Effective August 1, 2015.
