<u>Existing law</u> provides that the governing authority of any parish may form and create a tourist commission. Specifically creates certain tourist commissions including the Acadia Parish Convention and Visitors Commission.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that, unless otherwise provided, a commission shall be governed by a board of seven directors to be appointed by the governing authority of the parish. <u>New law</u> provides for an exception for the Acadia Parish Convention and Visitors Commission, which shall be governed by a board of 11 directors.

Effective August 1, 2015.
