SCHOOL EMPLOYEES RET. Provides relative to contributions of members out of service for five years. (6/30/16)

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 11:1149, relative to the Louisiana School Employees' Retirement
3	System; to provide relative to contributions of members out of service for five years;
4	to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.
5	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 11:1149 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§1149. Contributions of members out of service for five years
9	Whenever a member who has less than ten years of service credit has been
10	out of service for five years without having applied for a refund of contributions, the
11	retirement system shall transmit to him by certified mail, return receipt requested,
12	at his last known address, a notification of his rights with respect to the
13	contributions. The notification shall include information regarding his rights to
14	the refund of contributions, his rights to leave the contributions in the system if he
15	plans to reenter service, and his rights to use the contributions for reciprocity or
16	transfer of service credit if he becomes a member of another system, and any
17	rights he may have to a retirement allowance pursuant to R.S. 11:1142. If the

1	retirement system does not receive any response to the notification within ninety
2	days of mailing, the contributions to which the member is entitled shall be placed to
3	the credit of the pension accumulation fund. Upon a valid request for a refund of
4	contributions, such refund will be made from the pension accumulation annuity
5	<u>savings</u> fund.
6	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on June 30, 2016; if vetoed by the
7	governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on
8	June 30, 2016, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.

<u>Present law</u>, relative to the La. School Employees' Retirement System (LSERS), provides for notification procedures informing any member who has at least 10 years of service credit and who has been out of service for five years without having applied for a refund of contributions of his rights with respect to his contributions, including his right to a refund and his right to leave the contributions with the system if he plans to reenter service covered by LSERS on another system.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and specifies that the notification shall include information on his rights to use the contributions for a transfer of service credit and any rights he may have to receive a retirement allowance pursuant to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> provides that in the event the system does not receive any response to the notification within 90 days of mailing, the contributions shall be credited to the pension accumulation fund.

Proposed law removes the requirement to credit contributions to the annity savings fund.

Effective June 30, 2016.
