**Abstract:** Removes the governor's authority to veto line items in an appropriation bill.

<u>Present constitution</u> provides that the governor may veto any line item in an appropriation bill. <u>Present constitution</u> provides that any item vetoed is void unless the veto is overridden as prescribed for the passage of a bill over a veto. Requires the governor to veto line items or use means provided in the bill so that total appropriations for the year shall not exceed anticipated revenues for that year. (Note: Separate constitutional provisions (Art. X, §§13 and 51) protect amounts appropriated to State Civil Service, the Dept. of State Civil Service, and State Police Service from veto.)

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> repeals <u>present constitution</u>.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Nov. 8, 2016.
