2	To amend and reenact R.S. 33:385.1(A), relative to qualifications of an elected chief of
3	police; to provide relative to the town of Gueydan; and to provide for related matters.
4	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 33:385.1 (A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§385.1. Qualifications of elected chief of police
8	A. Except as otherwise provided in this Section, an elected chief of police of
9	a municipality shall be an elector of the municipality. At the time of qualification as
10	a candidate for the office of chief of police, he shall have been domiciled for at least
11	the immediately preceding year in the municipality except that a person who resides
12	outside of the corporate limits of the village of Maurice and the town of Gueydan
13	may be elected chief of police. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to the
14	village of Napoleonville.

Perry

<u>Present law</u> requires for an elected chief of police of a municipality to be an elector of the municipality.

<u>Present law</u> provides that at the time of qualification as a candidate for the office of chief of police, the candidate must have been domiciled for at least the immediately preceding year in the municipality. Provides as an exception that a person who resides outside of the corporate limits of the village of Maurice may be elected chief of police of Maurice.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds to the exception that a person who resides outside of the corporate limits of the town of Gueydan may be elected chief of police of the town of Gueydan.

Effective August 1, 2016.

(Amends R.S. 33:385.1 (A))
