Abstract: Recreates the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries until June 30, 2020.

<u>Present law</u> requires the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to terminate one year from July 1, 2016, and to begin the process of termination on July 1, 2016, unless legislation is enacted to recreate the department prior to that date.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to terminate on July 1, 2020, and to begin the process of terminating on July 1, 2020. Supersedes provisions of "Sunset Law" requiring certain procedures for recreation and a separate bill to recreate each statutory entity within the department.

Effective June 30, 2016.
