



- (2) A member of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker.
- (3) The chairman of the Louisiana Commission on Civic Education.
- (4) The state superintendent of education, or his designee.

Present law requires that an annual of the year's activities be submitted to the governor, the Senate and House committees on education, and the La. Commission on Civic Education by May 30. Proposed law changes reporting dates from May 30 to June 30. Otherwise retains present law.

Present law provides for a legislative chair and youth chair of the council. Provides that the legislative chair rotates annually between the advisory members from the Senate and the House of Representatives. Proposed law deletes the legislative chair and retains the youth chair.

Present law provides that council members serve without compensation; however, legislative advisory members receive mileage and per diem at the rate established by the legislature when attending meetings of the council. Proposed law provides that the legislators appointed as advisors shall receive such mileage and per diem when attending a council meeting. Otherwise retains present law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
