Morrish

<u>Present law</u> provides relative to the Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) as a program of merit scholarships for students attending certain postsecondary education institutions and who meet specific grade point average (GPA), ACT score, and core curriculum requirements and certain other qualifications.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the GPA requirement for initial eligibility for an Opportunity Award for students graduating from high school during or after the 2019-2020 school year <u>from</u> 2.50 <u>to</u> 2.75.

<u>Present law</u> provides for exceptions to the eligibility requirements for students graduating from high school in prior years. <u>Proposed law</u> retains these exceptions, but recodifies them in a new provision of law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
