Abstract: Provides an extension for coroners to report to the Department of Public Safety and Corrections and to the Louisiana Highway Safety Commission the death of any person as a result of a collision involving a motor vehicle and the circumstances surrounding it.

<u>Present law</u> requires a coroner to present a report within five days to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections and to the La. Hwy. Safety Commission regarding the death of any person as a result of an accident involving a motor vehicle and the circumstances surrounding it.

<u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> by increasing the time period for reporting <u>from</u> five days <u>to</u> 60 days. Also, modifies <u>present law</u> by replacing the word "accident" with "collision".

<u>Present law</u> requires every hospital to notify the coroner of the parish in which it is located of any death occurring in the hospital as a result of injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals the <u>present law</u> notification requirement.
