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<u>Present rule</u> establishes phase five of the Louisiana Children's Health Insurance Program (LaCHIP) as a stand-alone program under the provisions of Title XXI of the Social Security Act to provide coverage to uninsured children with family income from 200% to 250% of the federal poverty level.

<u>Present rule</u> provides that when family income is between 201% and 250% of the federal poverty level, families receiving services through the LaCHIP phase five program are responsible for paying a \$50 per month premium.

<u>Proposed rule</u> amends <u>present rule</u> to increase the monthly premium amount for which such families are responsible for paying from 50 to 565.
