**Abstract:** Authorizes seizing creditors to stop a sheriff's sale by written instruction.

<u>Present law</u> allows a property sale to be prevented prior to adjudication if payment is made to the sheriff of the judgment, with interest and costs.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and also prevents the sale of property prior to adjudication if the sheriff receives written instruction from the seizing creditor.
