**Abstract:** Prohibits charter schools from requiring parents to disclose medical information or special education needs of a student as a condition of enrollment in the school.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

<u>Present law</u> provides relative to charter school requirements, limitations, and prohibitions. Requires that charter school admission requirements include a system for admission decisions which precludes exclusion of students based on race, religion, gender, ethnicity, national origin, intelligence level, or identification as a student with an exceptionality as defined in <u>present law</u>. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> additionally prohibits a charter school from requiring a parent to disclose any medical information or special education needs for his child as a condition for enrolling the child in the school.
