Abstract: Prohibits the sale or offer for sale of warranties or extended service agreements for motor vehicles, either by mail or by telephone, by any person other than a manufacturer or dealer of motor vehicles.

<u>Proposed law</u> declares that it shall be unlawful for any person to sell or solicit for sale a warranty or extended service agreement, either by mail or by telephone, relative to a motor vehicle as defined in <u>present law</u> (R.S. 32:1252).

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes that any violation of <u>proposed law</u> shall be a deceptive and unfair trade practice and shall subject the violator to any and all actions and penalties provided for in <u>present law</u> (Chapter 13 of Title 51). Further, <u>proposed law</u> establishes that a violation occurs each time a warranty or extended service agreement relative to a motor vehicle is sold or solicited for sale either by mail or by telephone.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> shall not apply to any manufacturer or dealer of motor vehicles as defined in present law (R.S. 32:1252).
