MUSEUMS. Removes the Schepis Museum from the jurisdiction of the Department of State. (gov sig)

1	AN ACT
2	To repeal Chapter 5-S of Title 25 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of
3	R.S. 25:380.161 through 380.167, and to repeal R.S. 36:744(CC) and 801.23, relative
4	to the Schepis Museum; to remove the museum from the jurisdiction of the
5	Department of State and to delete all statutory provisions relative to the museum and
6	its advisory board; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. Chapter 5-S of Title 25 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,
9	comprised of R.S. 25:380.161 through 380.167, is hereby repealed.
10	Section 2. R.S. 36:744(CC) and 801.23 are hereby repealed.
11	Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
12	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
13	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
14	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
15	effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Present law</u> establishes the Schepis Museum in the Town of Colombia, in Caldwell Parish, under the overall jurisdiction of the Department of State and further provides for an advisory board for the museum.

Proposed law repeals present law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
