APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment in the matter of "Pamela Adams and Michael Adams v. State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2016-  
3 2017 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Pamela Adams and  
4 Michael Adams v. State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and  
5 Development"; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The sum of One Million One Hundred Fifty Thousand and No/100  
8 (\$1,150,000.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of  
9 Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit  
10 entitled "Pamela Adams and Michael Adams v. State of Louisiana, through the Department  
11 of Transportation and Development", bearing Number 609,634, Sec. "22", on the docket of  
12 the 19th Judicial District Court, parish of East Baton Rouge, state of Louisiana.

13 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2016; if vetoed by the governor  
14 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,  
15 2016, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
