# STUDENTS: Prohibits local public school boards from requiring school uniforms for students

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:416.7, relative to school uniform requirements; to prohibit a
3	city, parish, or other local public school board from requiring school uniforms for
4	students; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 17:416.7 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§416.7. Dress codes; authorization; notification requirement; school uniforms
8	prohibited
9	A. $(1)$ Each city, parish, or other local public school board may adopt such
10	rules and regulations as it deems necessary to implement a school dress code, which
11	may include the use of uniforms. Each school may select a uniform for its students
12	and shall display such uniform for a reasonable period prior to the proposed effective
13	date of the dress code.
14	(2) If a city, parish, or other local public school board adopts a school dress
15	code, it shall notify, in writing, the parent or guardian of each student of the dress
16	code specifications and their effective date.
17	(3) If a city, parish, or other local public school board adopts a new uniform
18	policy or modifies an existing uniform policy, it shall notify, in writing, the parent
19	or guardian of each student of the uniform policy adoption or uniform policy

3	B.(1) Nothing in this Section shall prohibit a city, parish, or other local
4	public school board from requiring a new dress code or uniform policy or modifying
5	an existing dress code or uniform policy without providing the required notice in the
6	event of what the school board deems an emergency. For the purposes of this
7	Subsection, "emergency" means an actual or imminent threat to health or safety
8	which may result in loss of life, injury, or property damage.
9	C. A city, parish, or other local public school board shall not require school
10	uniforms for students.
11	(2) <u>D.</u> Nothing in this Section shall require the additional expenditure of
12	school or school board funds.

Abstract: Prohibits local public school boards from requiring school uniforms for students.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes local public school boards to implement school dress codes for students including the use of uniforms. Requires the displaying of any uniform selected and requires notification to parents of any dress code specifications and uniform policy adoption or modifications. Permits school boards to require new or modified dress codes or uniform policies without notifying parents in cases of emergency. Provides that <u>present law</u> shall not require additional expenditures of school or school boards funds. <u>Proposed law</u> prohibits school boards from requiring uniforms for students. Removes the authority for school boards to adopt rules and regulations for the use of school uniforms and the authority to select uniforms. Further removes the requirements that school boards display uniforms and notify parents about the uniforms. Retains <u>present law</u> relative to dress codes.
