MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC: Repeals a prohibition against the Department of Public Safety and Corrections issuing an economic hardship license when a person's license is suspended due to tax issues

AN ACT

To repeal R.S. 32:414(R)(3), relative to economic hardship licenses; to repeal the prohibition against the Department of Public Safety and Corrections issuing an economic hardship license under certain circumstances; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 32:414(R)(3) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**Abstract:** Repeals a prohibition against the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections issuing an economic hardship license when an individual's license has been suspended due to a delinquent tax-related judgment from the Dept. of Revenue.

<u>Present law</u> requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to deny an individual an economic hardship license when that individual's driver's license is suspended and has not been renewed due to a judgment from the Dept. of Revenue.

Proposed law repeals present law.
