Abstract: Authorizes the La. Board of Pharmacy to collect an application fee for a new marijuana pharmacy permit.

<u>Present law</u> establishes the schedule of minimum amounts for fees to be collected by the La. Board of Pharmacy.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds a new marijuana pharmacy permit fee with a minimum amount of \$5000.
