<u>Present law</u> exempts certain persons named as a person in control in an approved Check or Money Transmitter application from having to give notice and receive approval of such transaction from the Commissioner of Financial Institutions.

<u>Proposed law</u> would repeal the exemption, meaning that all transactions provided for in the Sale of Checks and Money Transfer Act and conducted by a person named as a person in control shall first give notice to the commissioner of the proposed transaction and receive the approval of the commissioner in each instance.

Effective August 1, 2016.
