**Abstract:** Authorizes officials or employees of a city, parish, or other local public school system to provide student information in emergencies.

<u>Present law</u> provides the protection of student information by public schools.

<u>Present law</u> provides that no official or employee of a local public school system shall provide personally identifiable student information to any member of the school board or to any other person or public or private entity. <u>Present law</u> further provides that such an official or employee may, in accordance with applicable state and federal law, provide certain information in certain circumstances. <u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the provision of student information in a health or safety emergency; otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.
