INSURANCE DEPARTMENT. Provides with respect to a fraudulent insurance act.
(8/1/16)

AN ACT

To enact R.S. 22:1923(2)(n), relative to insurance fraud; to provide with respect to the definition of a fraudulent insurance act; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 22:1923(2)(n) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§1923. Definitions

As used in this Part, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated in this Section:

* * *

(2) "Fraudulent insurance act" shall include but not be limited to acts or omissions committed by any person who, knowingly and with intent to defraud:

* * *

(n) Presents, causes to be presented, or prepares with knowledge or belief that it will be presented to the Property Insurance Association of Louisiana, any oral or written statement which he knows to contain materially false information in connection with the grading by the Property Insurance Association of Louisiana of a municipality or fire district.
