HIGHER EDUCATION: (Constitutional Amendment) Authorizes the legislature to close or merge postsecondary education institutions under certain circumstances

6	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members	
7	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state of	
8	Louisiana, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to add	
9	Article VIII, Section 5(F) of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:

4	to the electors of the state of Louisiana at the statewide election to be held on November 8,	
5	2016.

7	there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted	
8	to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read a

Abstract: Authorizes the legislature to close or merge higher education institutions with a six-year graduation rate of less than 12%.

<u>Present constitution</u> creates the Bd. of Regents to plan, coordinate, and have budgetary responsibility for all public postsecondary education. Grants the board specific powers including the creation of new institutions and the elimination of programs.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> authorizes the legislature to provide for the closure or merger with another institution of any institution that has a six-year graduation rate of less than 12% over any five consecutive year period. Provides that any such law shall provide for the allocation of the assets and liabilities, the transfer of the students, the employment status of classified employees, the disposition of property, the successor of the institution for purposes of any pending legal action, and any other provision necessary for full dissolution of an institution.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Nov. 8, 2016.
