AGRICULTURE: Provides relative to the placement of advertisement signs on state-owned property

AN ACT
To enact R.S. 3:6, relative to the placement of advertising signs on state-owned property; to provide for the establishment of fees, rules, and regulations associated with the placement of signs on state-owned property; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 3:6 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
§6. Placing of advertising signs on state-owned property
A. The department may authorize the placement, erection, and maintenance of advertising and sponsorship signs on immovable property, improvements on immovable property, vehicles, vessels, airplanes, and assets of the department. B. The department shall establish appropriate and reasonable fees and promulgate rules and regulations in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to implement the provisions of this Section.
