2 To amend and reenact R.S. 17:4013(2)(a), relative to the Student Scholarships for 3 Educational Excellence Program; to provide with respect to eligibility of students 4 entering kindergarten in the voucher program; and to provide for related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 17:4013(2)(a) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 7 §4013. Definitions 8 As used in this Chapter, unless otherwise clearly indicated, the following 9 terms mean: 10 11 (2) "Eligible student" means a student who resides in Louisiana, is a member 12 of a family with a total income that does not exceed two hundred fifty percent of the 13 current federal poverty guidelines as established by the federal office of management 14 and budget, and who meets any one of the following criteria: 15 (a) Is entering kindergarten and any of the following applies to the student: 16 (i) Is in a public school system that assigns students to schools based upon 17 attendance zones and has enrolled in the local school system in which the public 18 school he would have otherwise attended is located received a letter grade of "D" or 19 "F" or any variation thereof for the most recent year pursuant to the school and district accountability system. or in a school under the jurisdiction of the Recovery 20

Abstract: Limits kindergarten student eligibility for the voucher program to kindergarten students who would have attended a "D" or "F" school, are siblings of voucher recipients, or received a voucher for the nonpublic pre-k voucher program.

<u>Present law</u> establishes a voucher program known as the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence Program.

<u>Present law</u> provides that to be eligible for a voucher a student shall reside in La., be a member of a family with a total income that does not exceed 250% of the current federal poverty guidelines, and shall meet any one of several criteria.

<u>Present law</u> provides that an entering kindergarten student is eligible for the voucher program if he has enrolled in the local school system in which the public school he would have otherwise attended is located or in a school under the jurisdiction of the Recovery School District.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that an entering kindergarten student who meets any of the following criteria is eligible for a voucher:

- (1) Is in a public school system that assigns students to schools based on attendance zones and the public school he would have attended received a letter grade of "D" or "F".
- (2) Is the sibling of a scholarship recipient.
- (3) Was enrolled in the Nonpublic School Early Childhood Development program at the school in which he is entering kindergarten.

<u>Present law</u> provides that each local school system or the Recovery School District shall conduct its annual kindergarten enrollment process and shall report such enrollment to the department prior to the program enrollment process. <u>Proposed law</u> removes <u>present law</u>.
