Abstract: Provides relative to access by boat for limited purposes to waters that have overflowed the banks of navigable streams or waterways.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that when the waters from a state-claimed navigable waterway overflows its bank or shore, a person shall have access by boat to such overflow waters for the purpose of recreational hook and line fishing.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that "hook and line" is limited to fishing with a rod with or without a reel.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that a person shall have access to the ordinary high stage of navigable waters in the Atchafalaya Basin for the purpose of commercial fishing.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the liability, if any, of a private owner for the recreational uses of property as authorized herein shall be limited as set forth in R.S. 9:2791 and 2795, which provide limitations of liability for private landowners when their property is used for certain recreational purposes.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that it shall not apply to private marshlands that are inundated with high tides, or to private canals inundated with overflow waters from a state-claimed navigable waterway.
