Abstract: Adds information that shall be included in a judgment of interdiction

<u>Present law</u> provides for procedures for the interdiction of certain persons. Provides certain requirements for the judgement of interdiction, but <u>present law</u> does not require the judgment to contain personal information of the defendant.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires judgments of interdiction to include the defendant's name, domicile, age, current address, and address following the interdiction hearing.
