**Abstract:** Prohibits the Department of Agriculture and Forestry from being declared an indispensable party for suits filed against the department in certain circumstances.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the department from being an indispensable party in any suit filed against a board or commission or its members if the majority of the board's appointments are not made by the commissioner.
