**Abstract:** Exempts any person engaged in the business of renting or selling new or used trolling motors from certain licensing requirements.

<u>Present law</u> enumerates definitions.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends definitions of the terms "marine dealer", "marine motor" or "marine engine", "marine product", "recreational products", and "recreational products dealer". <u>Proposed law</u> adds a definition for the term "trolling motor".

The changes made by <u>proposed law</u> effectually exempt any person engaged in the business of renting or selling new or used trolling motors who otherwise would not be required to be licensed as any classification of dealer pursuant to the provisions of <u>present law</u>.
