**Abstract:** Provides for the sale of sparkling wine or still wine when a Louisiana consumer is on the premises of the wine manufacturer or producer.

<u>Present law</u> allows wine manufacturers or producers to ship directly to consumers in Louisiana when certain conditions are satisfied. <u>Present law</u> further provides the conditions in which a wine manufacturer may ship directly to the consumer.

<u>Present law</u> does not include a sale of wine perfected on the premises of the wine producer or manufacturer.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the La. consumer to be physically present on the producer or manufacturer's premises and otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.
