**Abstract:** Authorizes a not-for-profit entity to retain the identity of a private funding source.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the legislative auditor to compile financial statements and to examine, audit, or review the books and accounts of certain state and local entities, including a quasi public agency or body. Further provides that a not-for-profit entity is a type of quasi public agency or body that may be subject to audit or review. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a not-for-profit entity, when reporting information to the legislative auditor as provided in <u>present law</u>, is not required to disclose the identity of a private donor.
