CHILDREN/FOSTER CARE: Provides relative to transportation of children to be admitted to a treatment facility under a physician's emergency commitment certificate

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact Children's Code Article 1431(D), relative to minors who are mentally
3	ill or suffering from substance abuse and in need of immediate medical treatment;
4	to provide relative to procedures pursuant to issuance of a physician's emergency
5	certificate for treatment of a minor; to provide relative to transportation of a child in
6	whose name an emergency certificate has been issued; to authorize certain persons
7	to accompany the child during such transportation; and to provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. Children's Code Article 1431(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read
10	as follows:
11	1431. Coroner's examination; emergency certificate
12	* * *
13	D.(1) If the examining physician determines that the provisions of this
14	Article are met, he shall execute an emergency certificate and shall transport or cause
15	to be transported the minor named in the emergency certificate to a treatment
16	facility.
17	(2)(a) Any child in whose name an emergency certificate has been issued
18	pursuant to this Article may be accompanied by any of the following persons during
19	transportation to a treatment facility:

Abstract: Authorizes certain persons to accompany a minor suffering from mental illness or substance abuse during transportation to a treatment facility pursuant to a physician's emergency certificate for treatment.

<u>Present law</u> provides for procedures pursuant to the issuance of a physician's emergency certificate for treatment of a minor suffering from mental illness or substance abuse. Provides that if the examining physician determines that certain requirements of present law are met, he shall execute an emergency certificate and shall transport or cause to be transported the minor named in the emergency certificate to a treatment facility.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>, and adds thereto an authorization for any of the following persons to accompany the minor during transportation to a treatment facility:

- (1) A parent, including a foster parent.
- (2) A legal guardian.
- (3) A Department of Children and Family Services case worker.

<u>Proposed law</u> stipulates that a biological parent of a child in foster care shall only accompany the child if approved by the Department of Children and Family Services.
