HOUSING/MANUFACTURED: Provides with respect to the disposition of abandoned mobile homes

1 AN ACT 2 To enact R.S. 9:5363.1(H), relative to abandoned mobile homes; to authorize certain persons 3 to take possession; to provide for procedures; and to provide for related matters. 4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 5 Section 1. R.S. 9:5363.1(H) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 6 §5363.1. Abandoned mobile homes; secured parties 7 8 H. An owner of immovable property upon which an abandoned mobile home 9 is located may take possession of the abandoned mobile home after one-hundred 10 eighty days have elapsed from the date of mailing notice to all secured parties.

**Abstract:** Authorizes the taking of possession of a mobile home by an owner of immovable property upon which the abandoned mobile home is located after providing notice to all secured parties.

<u>Present law</u> provides procedures for the taking of possession of a mobile home by secured parties upon default by the mortgagor.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the taking of possession of a mobile home by an owner of immovable property upon which the abandoned mobile home is located.

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CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a 180-day notice to secured parties prior to the owner of the immovable property taking possession.
