Abstract: Expands the definitions of "domestic abuse" and "qualified third party" as relates to housing accommodations for victims of domestic violence.

<u>Present law</u> provides certain accommodations and protections for victims of domestic violence with respect to housing.

<u>Present law</u> provides definitions of "domestic abuse" and "qualified third party" as relates those protections.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but adds rape to the definition of "domestic abuse" and adds sexual assault advocates to the definition of a "qualified third party".
