CIVIL/MOTIONS: Provides relative to motions for summary judgment

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact Code of Civil Procedure Article 966(A)(4), relative to motions for
3 summary judgment; to provide for procedures for motions for summary judgment;
4 to provide for the filing of certain documents; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. Code of Civil Procedure Article 966(A)(4) is hereby amended and
7 reenacted to read as follows:

8 Art. 966. Motion for summary judgment; procedure

9 A.

11 (4) The only documents that may be filed in support of or in opposition to
12 the motion are pleadings, memoranda, affidavits, depositions, answers to
13 interrogatories, admissions, certified medical records, and written stipulations, ~~and~~
14 ~~admissions~~. The court may permit documents to be filed in any electronically stored
15 format authorized by court rules or approved by the clerk of the court.

Abstract: Specifies which documents shall be filed in support or opposition of a motion for summary judgment.

Present law provides that the only documents that may be filed in support of or in opposition to the motion are pleadings, memoranda, affidavits, depositions, answers to interrogatories, certified medical records, written stipulations, and admissions.

Proposed law provides that the only documents that may be filed in support of or in opposition to the motion are pleadings, memoranda, affidavits, depositions, answers to interrogatories, admissions, certified medical records, and written stipulations.
