Abstract: Specifies which documents shall be filed in support or opposition of a motion for summary judgment.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the only documents that may be filed in support of or in opposition to the motion are pleadings, memoranda, affidavits, depositions, answers to interrogatories, certified medical records, written stipulations, and admissions.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the only documents that may be filed in support of or in opposition to the motion are pleadings, memoranda, affidavits, depositions, answers to interrogatories, admissions, certified medical records, and written stipulations.
