Present law provides relative to capital outlay funding.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if an entity or organization has received \$1,000,000 in capital outlay funding for a project that collects a general admission charge, such entity or organization shall designate one day each month where Louisiana residents are exempt from paying the general admission charge.
