MOTOR VEHICLES. Establishes a fixed period after establishing residency in Louisiana to have a vehicle registered and inspected. (8/1/16)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 47:513.2, relative to motor vehicles; to provide a fixed period for registration
3	and inspection of motor vehicles of new residents; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 47:513.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	§513.2. New residents; registration; inspection
7	A. Any person who is a new resident of Louisiana shall apply for a
8	certificate of registration for each motor vehicle he owns and operates on the
9	public streets and roadways in Louisiana within thirty days of the date he
10	establishes residency in Louisiana.
11	B. Any motor vehicle owned and operated by a new resident of Louisiana
12	on the public streets and roadways in Louisiana shall bear a valid safety
13	inspection certificate within thirty days of the date he establishes residency in
14	Louisiana.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a new resident of Louisiana to apply for a certificate of registration for each motor vehicle he owns and operates on the public streets and roadways in Louisiana within thirty days of the date he establishes residency in Louisiana.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires any motor vehicle owned and operated by a new resident of Louisiana on the public streets and roadways in Louisiana to bear a valid safety inspection certificate within thirty days of the date he establishes residency in Louisiana.

Effective August 1, 2016.
